When asked if pupils feel unsafe in school more than 5% of respondents said this was due to: 9% bullying or others being mean (-10%). No longer on the list: 6% fire alarm / lockdown

When asked where pupils feel unsafe in school more than 5% of respondents said: 8% playground (-3%). New to the list: 6% classroom. No longer on the list: 8% toilets, 5% cloakroom

Suggestions to make the school better raised by more than 5% of respondents: 19% more/better playground equipment (+11%); 6% more breaktimes. New to the list: 8% more trips or enrichment activities; 8% trampoline on playground; 8% school fayre; 8% school disco's; 8% class pets; 6% better PE equipment; 5% assembly chairs.

Termly Pupil Voice

Pupil Voice groups take place termly to get direct feedback from all Year 1-6 pupils about all aspects of our school provision.
